RELATING TO THE UNIFORM PARENTAGE ACT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The department of the attorney general
2	shall con	vene a task force to recommend amendments to the Hawaii

- (8) A mental health professional familiar with post adoption experience;
- 3 (9) An individual with personal knowledge of adoption4 related health and medical issues; and

- (c) The task force shall submit an interim report of its
  - 7 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
  - 8 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
  - 9 to the convening of the regular session of 2024, and a final
- 10 report no later than forty days prior to the convening of the

#### Report Title:

Uniform Parentage Act; Attorney General; Task Force; Report

#### Description:

Requires the department of the attorney general to convene a task force to recommend amendments to update existing parentage laws that reflect cisheteronormative concepts of families, parenthood, and parental rights. Requires an interim report to the legislature twenty days prior to the regular session of 2024 and a final report forty days prior to the regular session of 2025. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
