A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the single fastest
- 2 growing contributor to an increasing cost of living in Hawaii is
- 3 the rising cost of transportation. Due to increasingly
- 4 expensive fossil fuels and a lack of cheaper transit options,
- 5 Hawaii residents already pay among the highest costs to commute
- 6 in the country. In January 2022, the United States Bureau of
- 7 Labor Statistics reported that auto-related costs were an
- 8 astonishing twenty-three per cent higher in December 2021 than a
- 9 year earlier, accelerating a trend of increasing transit costs
- 10 contributing to Hawaii's rising cost of living.
- 11 The legislature further finds that numerous public
- 12 employees commute to work by car and must pay for parking at
- 13 their workplaces. However, public employees wishing to split
- 14 the cost of sharing a single stall while carpooling in different
- 15 cars on different days are currently prohibited by the
- 16 department of accounting and general services from doing so.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to help reduce the cost of
- 18 living and cost of transportation for public employees by:



- 1 (1) Enabling parking stall sharing between employees; and
- 2 (2) Providing secure bicycle storage lockers at public
- facilities.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 5 by adding one new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 "§27- Public employee parking facilities. (a) The
- 8 department of accounting and general services, in collaboration
- 9 with the department of transportation, shall develop, implement,
- 10 administer, and manage a program to allow two or more public
- 11 employees of the State to share the cost of a parking stall and
- 12 allow multiple cars to use that stall as appropriate; provided
- 13 that the total cost for sharing a parking stall between two or
- 14 more employees shall not exceed the cost of any one stall for
- 15 any one employee.
- 16 (b) The department of accounting and general services, in
- 17 collaboration with the department of transportation, shall
- 18 develop, implement, administer, and manage a pilot project to
- 19 provide a reasonable number of secure, enclosed bicycle storage
- 20 lockers at two facilities where vehicle parking is made
- 21 available to public employees of the State by the department of

- 1 accounting and general services; provided that the employee cost
- 2 of secure storage of a bicycle in an enclosed locker shall not
- 3 exceed twenty per cent of the cost of a vehicle parking stall."
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
