A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in 2022, the State
- 2 received over ten million dollars in federal money from the
- 3 Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration program, also known as the
- 4 Pittman-Robertson Dingell-Johnson/Wallop-Breaux program. The
- 5 purpose of the funds is to support sustainable fishing and
- 6 hunting and wildlife conservation throughout the Hawaiian
- 7 islands. The legislature further finds that in order to better
- 8 support local fishers, oversight of the funds' expenditures is
- 9 needed.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 11 auditor to conduct an audit of the department of land and
- 12 natural resources' aquatic resources division to determine how
- 13 funds received from the Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration
- 14 program have been expended in the State.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The auditor shall conduct an audit of the
- 16 department of land and natural resources' aquatic resources
- 17 division to determine how funds received from the federal



- 1 government through the Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration
- 2 program, also known as the Pittman-Robertson Dingell-
- 3 Johnson/Wallop-Breaux program, have been expended in the State.
- 4 The audit shall include the recipient and purpose of each
- 5 expenditure made with funds received from the Wildlife and Sport
- 6 Fish Restoration Program.
- 7 (b) The auditor shall submit a report of the auditor's
- 8 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 9 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 10 to the convening of the regular session of 2024.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
