SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF ALL THE PROGRAMS WITHIN THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources' 1 State Historic Preservation Division serves to protect and 2 preserve historic properties significant to Hawaii's history 3 through several program areas; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Division has 6 7 indicated that it has faced challenges with insufficient staffing and funding, which hinder its ability to carry out its 8 important duties and responsibilities in a timely manner; and 9 10 WHEREAS, under section 23-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the 11 12 Auditor may examine and inspect all accounts, books, records, 13 files, papers, and documents and all financial affairs of every department, office, agency, and political subdivision; 14 now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 17 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 18 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 19 requested to conduct a performance audit of all the programs 20 within the State Historic Preservation Division of the 21 Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the performance audit is requested to include but not be limited to: 25 26 An evaluation of whether the review and response to 27 (1) 28 submittals is completed within the timeframes established by rule; 29 30



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- 1 (2) Current project review practices, including efforts to identify categorical exemptions; historic properties 2 and districts that should have special protections or 3 treatment; identification of types of sites that do 4 not require permit review; filing systems; and efforts 5 to streamline processes such as the discovery process 6 for burial sites; 7 8 (3) Standardization of monitoring protocols, including the 9 establishment of cultural impact assessment guidance; 10 11 The actions, initiatives, and performance of the State 12 (4) Historic Preservation Division to address the existing 13 project review backlog; and 14 15 Any recommended improvements, including proposed 16 (5) legislation, to update, redefine or realign the State 17 Historic Preservation Division's mission and 18 organization based on balancing cultural and historic 19 20 preservation with the State's evolving land development needs; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor shall submit a 23 report of its findings and recommendations, including any 24 25 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Chairperson 29 of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and Administrator of 30 the State Historic Preservation Division. 31
