SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO: JOINTLY REVIEW ANY RESEARCH APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS FOR ADULTS; DEVELOP AND ADOPT RULES, POLICIES, AND PLAN AMENDMENTS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT THE STATE MEDICAID PROGRAM COVERS MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES, INCLUDING APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS SERVICES, FOR INDIVIDUALS AGED TWENTY-ONE AND OLDER WITH NEURODEVELOPMENTAL DISORDERS, INCLUDING AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER; AND APPLY FOR ANY NECESSARY APPROVALS FROM THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES TO AMEND THE STATE MEDICAID PLAN TO PROVIDE REIMBURSEMENTS FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES, INCLUDING APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS SERVICES, TO MEDICAID-ELIGIBLE PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE DIAGNOSED WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER.

WHEREAS, neurodevelopmental disorders are disabilities
 associated primarily with the functioning of the neurological
 system and brain; and

5 WHEREAS, one neurodevelopmental disorder is autism spectrum 6 disorder, a developmental disability that can cause significant 7 social, communication, and behavioral challenges; and 8

9 WHEREAS, treatments for individuals with developmental
10 disabilities, such as applied behavior analysis, can improve
11 physical and mental development; and

WHEREAS, Medicaid is a jointly-funded, federal-state health insurance program for individuals with limited income and resources who meet eligibility requirements; and 16

WHEREAS, the Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services
Waiver for individuals with intellectual and developmental
disabilities is authorized under section 1915(c) of the federal
Social Security Act (section 1915(c) waiver); and



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WHEREAS, these services are designed to implement creative, 1 2 person-centered alternatives to long-term institutionalized care; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, Hawaii's state Medicaid program, Med-QUEST, is administered through the Department of Human Services in 6 partnership with the Department of Health's Developmental 7 Disabilities Division; and 8 9 WHEREAS, there are reports of individuals with autism 10 spectrum disorder and other neurodevelopmental disorders who are 11 aged twenty-one and older being denied Med-QUEST coverage for 12 13 medically necessary autism services, including applied behavior analysis services; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, applied behavior analysis services and similar services should be covered by Med-QUEST for eligible individuals 17 with neurodevelopmental disorders; and 18 19 WHEREAS, according to the federal Centers for Medicare and 20 21 Medicaid Services' Informational Bulletin dated July 7, 2014, individuals aged twenty-one and older may continue to receive 22 23 services to address autism spectrum disorder through the section 24 1915(c) waiver if a state does not elect to provide these services to adults under its Medicaid state plan; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the Informational Bulletin also provides that 28 states need to ensure that these individuals are receiving a waiver service not coverable under section 1905(a) of the 29 30 federal Social Security Act to ensure that they do not lose access to all Medicaid services by losing waiver eligibility; 31 32 now, therefore, 33 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 34 35 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 36 37 Health and Department of Human Services are requested to: 38 Jointly review any research regarding applied behavior 39 (1) analysis for adults; 40 41



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Develop and adopt rules, policies, and plan amendments (2) 1 necessary to ensure that the State Medicaid program 2 covers medically necessary services, including applied 3 4 behavior analysis services, for individuals aged twenty-one and older with neurodevelopmental 5 disorders, including autism spectrum disorder; and 6 7 8 (3) Apply for any necessary approvals from the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to amend 9 the state Medicaid plan to provide reimbursements for 10 medically necessary services, including applied 11 behavior analysis services to Medicaid-eligible 12 persons over the age of twenty-one diagnosed with 13 autism spectrum disorder; and 14 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health and Department of Human Services are requested to ensure that any 17 rules, policies, and plan amendments adopted pursuant to this 18 request do not impair or limit any existing coverages; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health 22 and Director of Human Services. 23 24 IN 25 26 OFFERED BY:
