SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COUNTIES TO UPDATE THE DESIGN AND FORMAT OF
VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES IN RESPONSE TO GROWING ELECTRIC
VEHICLE AND HYBRID VEHICLE SALES.

1 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to
2 effectively manage the distribution and circulation of vehicle
3 registration plates, also known as license plates or number
4 plates, especially as consumer trends in the automotive industry
5 rapidly change; and

7 WHEREAS, Hawaii's rainbow license plate design is nearing
8 the end of its current numbering pattern and will need to
9 change; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the people of the State are seeking alternatives
12 to gasoline-powered vehicles as gasoline prices rise and harmful
13 emissions continue to warm our climate; and

14
15 WHEREAS, hybrid vehicle sales have been increasing as
16 consumers view these vehicles as a convenient middle ground
17 between conventional gasoline-powered vehicles and electric
18 vehicles; and

19
20 WHEREAS, electric vehicle adoption is growing
21 exponentially, with many major car manufacturers phasing out
22 gasoline-powered cars completely by 2035; and

23
24 WHEREAS, as a result, Hawaii's temporary electric vehicle
25 license plate numbering scheme needs to be changed to keep up
26 with this demand; and

27
28 WHEREAS, electric vehicle license plates in the State
29 currently use four characters, three of which are numbers and
30 one of which is a letter; and

1 WHEREAS, at the current pace of electric vehicle sales, the
2 current alphanumeric scheme will last for only five years; and

4 WHEREAS, updating the present license plate schemes is
5 necessary to accommodate shifting trends for electric, hybrid,
6 and gasoline-powered vehicle sales in the State; now, therefore,
7

8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
9 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the
10 House of Representatives concurring, that the counties are
11 requested to update the design and format of vehicle
12 registration plates in response to the growing electric vehicle
13 and hybrid vehicle sales; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that beginning January 1, 2025, that
16 the Director of Finance of each county is requested to issue
17 number plates in the following manner:
18

- 19 (1) Number plates for electric vehicles should bear the
20 word "Hawaii" along the upper portion of the plate and
21 the words "Aloha State" along the lower portion of the
22 plate and contain a colorful design reflecting the
23 State's unique environment;

- 25 (2) Number plates for hybrid vehicles should bear the word
26 "Hawaii" on the upper portion of the plate and the
27 words "hybrid vehicle" on any portion of the plate and
28 use the rainbow design featured on number plates,
29 except special number plates, issued in the State
30 beginning in 1991; and

- 32 (3) Number plates for gasoline-powered vehicles should
33 bear the word "Hawaii" along the upper portion of the
34 plate and the words "gas vehicle" on any portion of
35 the plate and use the rainbow design featured on
36 number plates, except special number plates, issued in
37 the State beginning in 1991; and
