SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH A WORKING GROUP TO EVALUATE OPTIONS THAT PROVIDE ADDITIONAL AIR SERVICE TO REMOTE AND UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE STATE.

WHEREAS, as an island state, Hawaii is reliant upon air 1 travel to ensure residents and tourists have timely 2 transportation options to navigate between islands; and 3 4 WHEREAS, since January 2021, only one passenger airline has 5 provided service to the general public out of Molokai Airport; 6 7 and 8 9 WHEREAS, while the airline does their best to accommodate the needs of passengers, including additional routes, flight 10 times, and ordering larger planes, the cost of plane tickets 11 remains a burden to many Molokai residents who need to travel 12 for essential reasons, including work, medical appointments, and 13 family; and 14 15 WHEREAS, in addition to costly ticket prices and limited 16 flights, there are significant flight delays and cancellations 17 18 that have caused undue burden on Molokai residents; and 19 WHEREAS, presently, airlines and air travel are regulated 20 by the Federal Aviation Administration; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the lack of consistent, available flights between 23 rural communities and major hubs such as Honolulu pose a health 24 and safety issue; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the collaboration of federal, state, and county 27 agencies is needed to ensure residents who live in rural or 28 underserved communities have greater access to air travel 29 options for essential reasons; now, therefore, 30 31

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 1 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 2 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 3 Transportation is urged to establish a working group to evaluate 4 options that provide additional air service to remote and 5 underserved communities across the State; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 8 9 to evaluate options, including: 10 (1) An airline subsidy to offset the cost of passenger 11 12 tickets; and 13 14 (2) Encouragement of other airlines to provide service at rural airports, including Molokai Airport; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to consist of the following members: 18 19 20 (1)The Manager of the Federal Aviation Administration 21 Honolulu Airports District Office; 22 23 (2) The Deputy Director for Transportation - Airports, or 24 their designee; 25 26 (3) The Chairperson of the Public Utilities Commission, or their designee; 27 28 29 (4) A representative from each county transportation 30 department; and 31 32 (5) Any additional members whose expertise may be relevant 33 and as recommended by the working group; and 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, 36 37 including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later 38 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and 39 40 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested to be dissolved on June 30, 2024; and 42
