SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES REGULATING VESSEL SPEED NEAR HUMPBACK WHALES.

1 WHEREAS, humpback whales are an endangered species and the official marine mammal of the State; and 2 3 WHEREAS, humpback whales play a crucial role in marine 4 ecosystems, and humpback whale populations are closely tied to 5 the health of the oceans; and 6 7 WHEREAS, collisions between vessels and humpback whales can 8 result in significant humpback whale injuries or deaths; and 9 10 WHEREAS, collisions with humpback whales are greatly 11 reduced when vessels travel at speeds of fifteen knots or less; 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS, in 2022, the Pacific Whale Foundation, the 15 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and the State 16 released a new set of voluntary recommendations for boaters 17 operating around humpbacks, including suggested speeds and the 18 use of lookouts; and 19 20 WHEREAS, adopting these recommendations as administrative 21 22 rules will help to protect and preserve humpback whales; now, 23 therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 26 27 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested to adopt rules pursuant to 28 29 chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to: 30

1 Prohibit any person from operating a vessel other than (1)2 an inter-island vessel or intra-island vessel as defined in section 19-41-2, Hawaii Administrative 3 Rules, within the waters of the State at a speed 4 5 exceeding: 6 7 (A) Fifteen knots when the vessel is within waters of 8 one hundred fathoms in depth or less during 9 humpback whale season; and 10 Six knots when the vessel is within four hundred (B) 11 yards of a humpback whale; and 12 13 14 (2) Require any person operating a vessel other than an inter-island vessel or intra-island vessel as defined 15 in section 19-41-2, Hawaii Administrative Rules, 16 within the waters of the State to: 17 18 (A) Ensure that if another person on the vessel is 19 available, that person should serve as a lookout 20 21 to prevent collisions with humpback whales when the vessel is within waters of one hundred 22 fathoms in depth or less during humpback whale 23 24 season; and 25 (B) Operate the vessel in a manner that is reasonable 26 and prudent to avoid collision with a humpback 27 whale, considering the time of day, time of year, 28 and other relevant factors; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 31 Natural Resources is also requested to exclude barges from any 32 rules adopted in accordance with this measure; and 33 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 36 37 Board of Land and Natural Resources.
