SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HAWAII-TAIWAN FRIENDSHIP TASKFORCE TO EXPLORE WAYS TO STRENGTHEN, IMPROVE, AND EXPAND ECONOMIC, CULTURAL, AND EDUCATIONAL RELATIONS BETWEEN HAWAII AND TAIWAN.

1 WHEREAS, Taiwan shares with the United States the universal values of freedom, democracy, and respect for human rights and 2 the rule of law; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Taiwan and Hawaii have an established sister-state 5 relationship since 1993, and sister-city or sister-county 6 7 relationships have been established between Honolulu and Kaohsiung City, Maui County and Pingtung County, Hawaii County 8 and Hualien County, and Kauai County and Penghu County; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii Office in Taipei and the 11 Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Honolulu have worked 12 together to promote cooperation and exchanges in tourism, 13 agriculture, culture, education, and trade; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Taiwan's export and import volume reached 16 17 \$500,000,000,000 and \$300,000,000,000, respectively, in 2022, and the International Monetary Fund ranks Taiwan as the twenty-18 second largest economy in the world; and 19 20 WHEREAS, before the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic, 21 22 Taiwanese citizens made over seventeen million trips abroad; and 23 WHEREAS, with loosening travel restrictions, there is 24 25 tremendous potential for Taiwanese visitors to Hawaii to further help revitalize Hawaii's tourism sector; and 26 27

WHEREAS, in 2021, Taiwan was Hawaii's tenth-largest trade 1 partner, with exports to Hawaii totaling \$54,000,000, and 2 imports from Hawaii totaling \$13,000,000; now, therefore, 3 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 6 House of Representatives concurring, that the Office of the 7 8 Governor is requested to establish a Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship Taskforce; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship 11 Taskforce is requested to explore ways to strengthen, improve, 12 and expand economic, cultural, and educational relations between 13 Hawaii and Taiwan; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship 16 17 Taskforce is requested to comprise nine members as follows: 18 (1) Three members appointed by the Governor; 19 20 Three members appointed by the President of the 21 (2) 22 Senate; and 23 (3) Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of 24 25 Representatives; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship Taskforce are requested to elect a 28 29 chair and vice chair from among the members; and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship 31 Taskforce is requested to submit a report of its findings and 32 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 33 34 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 35 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii-Taiwan Friendship 38 Taskforce shall cease to exist on June 30, 2025; and 39 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and 41
