SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO TRANSFER THE EWA BEACH PUBLIC AND SCHOOL LIBRARY FROM THE STATE PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM TO JAMES CAMPBELL HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1971, the Ewa Beach Public and 1 2 School Library opened on the James Campbell High School campus with the dual purpose of serving as both a school library and a 3 community library; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Ewa Beach Public and School Library is 6 administratively established within the Hawaii Public Library 7 System and the hours are established by the State Librarian, 8 subject to state library funding; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the library is currently open on Mondays and 11 Tuesdays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 12 13 p.m., Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Fridays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., 14 and is closed on Saturdays and Sundays, which are not convenient 15 operational hours for the students of nearby James Campbell High 16 School, Pohakea Elementary School, and Ilima Intermediate 17 School; and 18 19 WHEREAS, establishing the Ewa Beach Public and School 20 Library as part of James Campbell High School will help to 21 ensure that the library is more accessible to the students of 22 the nearby schools; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the 26 House of Representatives concurring, the Department of Education 27 is requested to transfer the Ewa Beach Public and School Library 28 from the Hawaii State Public Library System to James Campbell 29 High School; and 30 31
