SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF ALL THE PROGRAMS WITHIN THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources' State Historic Preservation Division serves to protect and 2 preserve historic properties significant to Hawaii's history 3 4 through several program areas; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Division has 7 indicated that it has faced challenges with insufficient staffing and funding, which hinder its ability to carry out its 8 9 important duties and responsibilities in a timely manner; and 10 WHEREAS, under section 23-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the 11 12 Auditor may examine and inspect all accounts, books, records, files, papers, and documents and all financial affairs of every 13 department, office, agency, and political subdivision; 14 15 now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 18 19 that the Auditor is requested to conduct a performance audit of 20 all the programs within the State Historic Preservation Division 21 of the Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the performance audit is requested to include but not be limited to: 24 25 26 (1)Whether the State Historic Preservation Division has adequate staffing and resources to conduct timely 27 28 project reviews; 29 (2) 30 An evaluation of whether the review and response to submittals is completed within the timeframes 31 32 established by rule; 33 Current project review practices, including efforts to 34 (3) identify categorical exemptions; historic properties 35



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1 2 3 4 5 6		and districts that should have special protections or treatment; identification of types of sites that do not require permit review; filing systems; and efforts to streamline processes such as the discovery process for burial sites;
7 8	(4)	Record retention methodologies;
9 10 11	(5)	Standardization of monitoring protocols, including the establishment of cultural impact assessment guidance;
12 13 14	(6)	The actions, initiatives, and performance of the State Historic Preservation Division to address the existing project review backlog; and
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16 17 18	(7)	Any recommended improvements, including proposed legislation, to update, redefine or realign the State Historic Preservation Division's mission and
19 20 21		organization based on balancing cultural and historic preservation with the State's evolving land development needs; and
22 23 24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any	
25 26 27	proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and	
28 29 30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and Administrator of the
