SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT TO IDENTIFY LANDS IN WEST AND SOUTH MAUI THAT ARE APPROPRIATE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF KAUHALE HOUSING FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS.

WHEREAS, homelessness is a critical issue in the State of 1 2 Hawaii; and 3 WHEREAS, according to the Bridging the Gap CoC Homeless 4 Point-in-Time Count, January 23, 2022, report, there were seven 5 hundred forty-one homeless individuals in the County of Maui on 6 7 January 23, 2022, with three hundred five of those individuals in homeless shelters and four hundred thirty-six of those 8 individuals not in a shelter; and 9 10 WHEREAS, providing kauhale housing, which incorporates 11 traditional Hawaiian values of community and sustainability, has 12 been identified as a promising approach to addressing 13 14 homelessness; and 15 WHEREAS, west and south Maui have been identified as areas 16 with a high concentration of homeless individuals, and there is 17 18 a need for more affordable housing in these areas; now, 19 therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 22 that the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development is 23 requested to identify lands in west and south Maui that are 24 appropriate for the construction of kauhale housing for homeless 25 26 individuals; and 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning and 28 29 Sustainable Development is requested to consult with the County of Maui Department of Housing and Human Concerns, community 30 organizations, and other stakeholders in identifying suitable 31 lands for the construction of kauhale housing; and 32 33



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Office of
Planning and Sustainable Development and Mayor of the County of
Maui.
