SENATE RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE RULES OF THE SENATE OF THE THIRTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII, REGULAR SESSION OF 2023, BY ADOPTING A NEW RULE 27.5, FLOOR SESSION ATTIRE.

WHEREAS, the Senate has traditionally required its members 1 to wear court attire during floor sessions, except for Fridays; 2 and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, this requirement is contrary to the attire of most of the community, in which the use of aloha attire is 6 predominant, and more formal attire such as jackets and ties is 7 often the exception rather than the rule; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, allowing members of the Senate to wear aloha attire during all daily floor sessions would align the chamber 11 with local norms and would demonstrate support for the State's 12 garment industry; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Article III, Section 12, of the Constitution of 15 the State of Hawaii specifically grants to each chamber the 16 power to determine the rules of its proceedings; now, therefore, 17 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 20 that the Rules of the Senate be amended by adding Senate Rule 21 27.5, Floor Session Attire, to read as follows: 22 23 "Rule 27.5 Floor Session Attire. 24 25 When present on the floor of the Senate Chamber, each 26 member shall be dressed in aloha attire or court attire. "Court 27 attire" means coat and tie for men and jackets for women."; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that new Senate Rule material is 30 31 underscored; and
