## SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A JUNIOR POLICE PILOT PROGRAM AT FARRINGTON HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Honolulu Police Department is suffering from a 1 2 chronic staffing shortage; and 3 WHEREAS, as of May 2022, the Honolulu Police Department had 4 1,828 sworn officers and three hundred forty-nine vacancies; and 5 6 WHEREAS, worker shortages in the Honolulu Police Department 7 8 leads to certain police beats understaffed; and 9 WHEREAS, certain shifts in Department District 1, which 10 includes Downtown Honolulu, Chinatown, and Kakaako, are staffed 11 at only seventy-seven percent of its usual staffing needs; and 12 13 WHEREAS, staffing shortages also limit the time police 14 officers have to work with the community, preventing officers 15 from building deep relationships with community members and 16 business owners; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the Honolulu Police Department is highly selective in its recruitment efforts to ensure that only the best, most 20 qualified candidates become police officers that serve and 21 protect local communities; and 22 23 WHEREAS, in the last two years, just over five percent of 24 the thousands of applicants who signed up to take the police 25 entrance exam became police recruits; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, expanding the overall pool of quality applicants 29 through a junior police pilot program at high schools will support the effort of the Honolulu Police Department to select 30 qualified police recruits who meet the Department's high 31 standards; now, therefore, 32 33 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 34 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, 35
