# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, OFFICE OF PLANNING AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, AND DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO JOINTLY EVALUATE EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE TO DETERMINE CURRENT SEWER CAPACITIES AND PROJECTED FUTURE CAPACITY NEEDS FOR DEVELOPMENT ALONG TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT SPECIAL DISTRICTS.

1 WHEREAS, development projects in transit-oriented  
2 development special districts like Aloha Stadium and Pearlridge  
3 Center are implemented and overseen by the City and County of  
4 Honolulu; and

6 WHEREAS, the State has an interest in the development of  
7 future projects along transit-oriented development and yet, has  
8 no way of gauging the capacity of sewers and related  
9 infrastructure in these districts; and

11 WHEREAS, in order to make informed decisions regarding the  
12 planning and development of transit-oriented development special  
13 districts, the State must work jointly with the City and County  
14 of Honolulu to evaluate and understand the needs and capacities  
15 of facilities in these areas; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second  
18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023,  
19 that the Department of Transportation and the Office of Planning  
20 and Sustainable Development are requested to convene with the  
21 Department of Environmental Services of the City and County of  
22 Honolulu to jointly evaluate the current infrastructure of  
23 transit-oriented development special districts to determine  
24 current sewer capacities and projected future capacity needs;

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of  
28 Transportation, Office of Planning and Sustainable Development,  
29 and Department of Environmental Services of the City and County


9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
