Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 870, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE NEIGHBOR ISLANDS BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED SERVICE PILOT PROGRAM,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish and fund a fouryear Neighbor Islands Blind and Visually Impaired Service Pilot Program and working group to supplement existing statewide services by providing training and other services to neighbor island residents who are blind or visually impaired.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the National Federation of the Blind of Hawaii, National Organization of Parents of Blind Children, and eight individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Human Services.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation to an unspecified amount; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.
