The purpose of this measure is to:

- Extend the time period that the Family Court may order continued assisted community treatment from one year to two years; and
- (2) Reduce the time period that the Family Court needs to determine whether assisted community treatment should continue from one hundred eighty days to one hundred days.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the State Council on Mental Health and one individual. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Health and Hawaii Disability Rights Center.

Your Committee finds that this measure would support assisted community treatment, which is an important tool that helps individuals with behavioral health issues receive necessary

medical treatment, including treatment over the individual's objection.


