Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 95, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PARTIAL PUBLIC FINANCING OF ELECTIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Increase the amount of funds available to candidates who qualify to participate in the partial public financing program;
- (2) Adjust the minimum amount of qualifying contributions certain candidates must receive to participate in the partial public financing program; and
- Increase the matching fund payments to candidates in the partial public financing program for excess qualifying contributions.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Campaign Spending Commission, League of Women Voters of Hawaii, Americans for

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Changing the effective date to June 30, 3000, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.
