The purpose of this measure is to request the University of Hawaii at Manoa College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources to convene a working group to evaluate updating its extension sites.

Your Committee finds that modern agricultural research, extension, and education facilities provide the foundation for cutting-edge research and applied science solutions that address climate change, agricultural profitability, food safety, biosecurity, nutrition, and food security. Despite the recognized importance of these facilities and the work they pursue, the College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources is facing unprecedented infrastructure challenges due to years of underinvestment and deferred maintenance. Your Committee further finds that convening a working group to evaluate updating the
