Your Committee on Higher Education & Technology, to which was referred S.B. No. 1415, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the University of Hawaii to submit annual reports of all University of Hawaii employees who performed work from a location outside of the State during the applicable year to the Legislature no later than December 31 of that year.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from numerous individuals.

Your Committee finds that as opportunities and technological capabilities for remote work increase, the cost of living in the State continues to rise, and the local unemployment rate remains low, more workers at the University of Hawaii may be working from out-of-state locations. Your Committee further finds that the data sought by this measure will promote an understanding of the type of work being filled elsewhere; opportunities for education, research, and training that might allow the positions to be filled locally; and the extent to which the State's workforce is capable

of meeting the employment needs of the State's higher education system.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing the effective date to June 30, 3000, to encourage further discussion.
