Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 182, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A. BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DISCLOSURES OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to amend:

- (1)The filing deadline for disclosures of financial interest by candidates for state elective office or the constitutional convention;
- The penalty for the unauthorized release of confidential (2) financial disclosure information; and
- The fines imposed and administrative procedures relating (3) to disclosures of financial interests.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Hawai'i State Ethics Commission and three individuals.

Your Committee finds that the current collection process for assessing ethics fines is unnecessarily complex and expensive.

This measure would modernize the administrative process by allowing the fine to be assessed through a notice and order.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Changing the effective date to June 30, 3000, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 182, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 182, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Finance.
