Sir:

Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 372, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES RELATING TO THE LAW,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Require that a law enforcement officer has a duty to intervene if the law enforcement officer reasonably believes that another law enforcement officer is using unnecessary or excessive force on an arrestee;
- (2) Require the law enforcement officer to report the incident to the other law enforcement officer's supervisor; and
- (3) Require relevant departments to submit annual reports to the Legislature.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Honolulu Police Department, American Civil Liberties Union of Hawai'i, Policing Project at NYU School of Law, and seven individuals. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to

this measure from the State of Hawaii Organization of Police Officers.

Your Committee finds that this measure will reduce the number of violent and even fatal interactions between police and community members, keep law enforcement officers accountable, and help improve public confidence and trust in law enforcement.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Making it effective upon approval; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 372, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 372, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.
