Your Committee finds that it is important to ensure that car sharing operations do not negatively impact residential neighborhoods, that residents' rights are protected, and that these operations comply with local zoning and business ordinances. Your Committee further finds that persons utilizing car sharing platforms may conduct business from their personal residence, creating traffic, noise, and safety concerns within neighborhoods. Your Committee therefore finds that this measure urges greater

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accountability and oversight of car sharing platforms to preserve the character of residential neighborhoods.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 33, S.D. 1, and recommends its adoption.
