Your Committees on Transportation and Culture and the Arts and Public Safety and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, to which was referred S.R. No. 110 entitled:

"SENATE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS TO COLLABORATE WITH THE OFFICE OF VETERANS' SERVICES TO PLAN AND CONSTRUCT MEMORIALS TO HONOR THE SACRIFICES AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF VETERANS FROM HAWAII,"

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of Veterans' Services, Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, and one individual. Your Committees received comments on this measure from the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts.

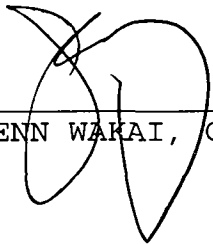
