SB 388 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES.  Prohibits the construction, modification, or expansion of any waste or disposal facility for hazardous waste or solid waste on land that is near or above a significant aquifer as determined by the Department of Health, in consultation with the Commission on Water Resource Management.	Pending re-referral to AEN/JDC
SB 773 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION. Requires a landowner in possession of 10,000 or more acres to be liable for damages and fines arising from runoff originating on the land and entering into state waters or onto state lands. Requires the Department of Health to adopt rules as necessary for the purposes of this provision.	Pending re-referral to AEN/JDC
SB 788 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO VEGETATIVE BURNING. Prohibits the Department of Health from issuing permits for commercial burning of green waste products in residential areas or within one thousand feet of a residential property.	Pending re-referral to AEN/JDC
