<u>SB 948</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES. Appropriates funds to allow the Division of Forestry and Wildlife to coordinate the removal of hazard albizia trees that potentially threaten public and private land.	AEN/WTL, WAM
<u>SB 1498</u> <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF TARO. Prohibits the Board of Land and Natural Resources from disturbing or acquiring for development certain wetland taro-growing lands. Establishes a taro lands classification for public lands. Permits structures for loi taro fields in the agricultural district. Establishes growth and perpetuation of traditional Hawaiian crops as a goal of the Hawaii State Planning Act. Authorizes the Land Use Commission to create an inventory of taro lands and consult with former members of the Taro Security and Purity Task Force in the creation of the inventory.	AEN/WTL, WAM

<u>SB 1521</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE LAND USE. Requires the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development to create an integrated land use plan for the use the agricultural district. Requires the Hawaii State Energy Office, Department of Agriculture, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Department of Transportation, Hawaii Tourism Authority to update various state functional plans. Requires the counties to update their general plans. Appropriates moneys.	WTL/AEN, WAM
