SB 756 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Establishes the Access to Local Food Act to allow cottage food operations to sell cottage food products, under certain conditions, upon receiving a permit from the Department of Health.	AEN, CPN
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Establishes a program specialist position within the Department of Agriculture and appropriates moneys to fund the position. RELATING TO WASTE MANAGEMENT. **SB 1458** AEN, WAM/CPN Establishes an Extended Producer Responsibility Program. Phases out all existing large concentrated animal feeding operations by 7/1/2028. **SB 1588** RELATING TO FOOD SAFETY. AEN, WAM Appropriates funds to the Department of Agriculture to establish Status & and implement a GroupGAP food safety training and certification
