Allows the Chief Energy Officer of the Hawaii State Energy Office to enforce minimum efficiency standards and adopt or amend efficiency standards. Sets minimum efficiency standards for air purifiers, electric vehicle supply equipment, portable electric spas, residential ventilating EEP. CPC

fans, toilets, urinals, and water coolers. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)
