SB 397 RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL MEDICAID SERVICES. HHS, WAM

Status & Appropriates funds to increase Medicaid payments to eligible health care professionals in the State up to one hundred per

cent of the current Medicare rates.

SB 404 RELATING TO THE HOSPITAL SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM. HHS, WAM

Expands the Hospital Sustainability Program and makes the program permanent. Amends the definition of "private hospital". Increases the fee cap on various hospital sustainability fees. Requires the Department of Human Services to consult and negotiate with the hospital trade association located in Hawaii regarding fee participation and rates. Requires the Hospital Sustainability Fee to discontinue under certain circumstances and provides guidelines for the distribution of remaining funds.

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Appropriates funds out of the Hospital Sustainability Program

Special Fund.

RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. **SB 102** HHS, WAM Exempts services provided by a hospital, infirmary, medical Status & clinic, health care facility, pharmacy, or licensed medical **Testimony** practitioner from the general excise tax. RELATING TO THE RETENTION OF HEALTH CARE **SB 761** HHS, WAM PROVIDERS. Status & Beginning July 1, 2024, provides a general excise tax exemption **Testimony** for medical services performed by health care providers. **SB 1472** RELATING TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES. HHS, WAM Appropriates funds for the expansion and enhancement of the Status & suicide crisis hotline and crisis management services provided **Testimony** by contracted service providers through the Hawaii CARES Crisis Helpline; expansion and enhancement of the crisis mobile outreach services provided by contracted service providers through the Hawaii CARES Crisis Helpline; expansion of licensed crisis residential shelter services provided by contracted service providers through the Hawaii CARES Crisis Helpline; and expansion of bed stabilization services provided by contracted service providers through the Hawaii CARES Crisis Helpline. **SB 1035** RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. HHS, WAM/CPN Exempts medical services provided by health care providers to Status & patients who receive Medicaid, Medicare, or TRICARE benefits **Testimony** from the general excise tax. Applies to taxable years beginning 1/1/2024. RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX. **SB 1118** HHS, WAM Reduces and eliminates the general excise tax for the sale of Status & groceries that are eligible under the Supplemental Nutrition **Testimony** Assistance Program or Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children over a four-year period. Reduces and eliminates the general excise tax for the sale of nonprescription drugs, medical supplies, and durable medical equipment over a four-year period. RELATING TO HEALTH CARE SERVICES. **SB 1128** HHS, WAM Exempts gross proceeds from medical services provided by Status & physicians and advanced practice registered nurses acting in **Testimony** the capacity of a primary care provider from the general excise tax. Effective 1/1/2024. RELATING TO TAXATION. **SB 1134** HHS, WAM Exempts medical services from the general excise tax. Status & **Testimony SB 1239** RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX. HHS, WAM Exempts certain medical services, food, and rent from the Status & general excise tax. **Testimony SB 1348** RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTIONS. HHS, WAM Exempts certain groceries, feminine hygiene products,

incontinence products, and over-the-counter drugs from the

general excise tax.
