HB 384, HD2  (HSCR1186)  Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PARENTAGE. Enacts portions of the Uniform Parentage Act of 2017 to replace the Uniform Parentage Act of 1973. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD2)	JDC
HB 707, HD1  (HSCR818)  Status & Testimony	RELATING TO FALSE CLAIMS.  Makes it a class C felony to make false, fictitious, or fraudulent claims against the State or a county, or any of their departments or agencies. Disqualifies a person convicted of making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim from receiving public financing for elections for a period of ten years. (HD1)	JDC
HB 711, HD1  (HSCR819)  Status & Testimony	RELATING TO FRAUD. Establishes the offense of fraud as a class B felony. Disqualifies a person charged with fraud from receiving public financing for elections for a period of ten years. (HD1)	JDC
HB 727, HD1  (HSCR820)  Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FUNDS.  Disallows the use of campaign funds to purchase up to two tickets for an event or fundraiser held by another candidate or committee. (HD1)	JDC

RELATING TO COMPLAINTS ALLEGING VIOLATIONS OF **JDC** HB 732, HD1 CAMPAIGN SPENDING LAWS. (HSCR821) Allows the campaign spending commission to treat a respondent's failure to explain or otherwise respond to a Status & **Testimony** complaint alleging a violation of campaign spending laws as a rebuttable presumption that a violation has occurred. (HD1) **HB 985** RELATING TO GOVERNMENT FRAUD. **JDC** Adds a new section to chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to (HSCR796) establish the class C felony offense of government fraud. Status & **Testimony** HB 986, HD1 RELATING TO OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT. **JDC** Establishes the class C felony offense of official misconduct to (HSCR813) prohibit a person, when in the person's official capacity, from acting or refraining from performing an official duty to obtain a Status & Testimony benefit other than the person's lawful compensation or submitting or inviting reliance on any false statement, document,

or record. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

- Testifiers for this hearing will be limited to 2 minutes each.
