## RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

Status & Testimony

Requires the technology services consolidation working group to decommission the Office of Enterprise Technology Services' data center located in the Kalanimoku building; relocate the entire Office of Enterprise Technology Services data center to a single, standalone facility; and use cloud storage for all state data. Extends to 6/30/28 the dissolution date of the technology services consolidation working group. Establishes requirements for procurement contracts for information technology-related projects.

## RELATING TO CHILD CARE.

GVO/LBT, WAM

Status & Testimony

Requires the Department of Accounting and General Services to establish and operate a child care center pilot program on Oahu for eligible children of state employees, one in or near the state capitol and one in Kapolei. Appropriates funds. Repeals on 6/30/2028.
