SB 468 RELATING TO AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES.

Authorizes the Department of Land and Natural Resources to adopt rules to prevent and respond to the introduction of aquatic nuisance species from discharges incidental to the normal operation of a vessel and reflect the relationship between the WTL/TCA, JDC

federal Vessel Incidental Discharge Act of 2018, as amended,

emergency oxygen, and an automated external defibrillator

and state law.

SB 1263 RELATING TO COMMERCIAL OCEAN RECREATION.

Requires commercial ocean operators who take customers into state waters to engage in recreational activities to have at least one individual aboard the vessel who is rescue diver or lifeguard certified by a nationally recognized certification organization.

Requires vessels that transport customers for the purpose of engaging in an activity in state waters to have a backboard,

included in its onboard safety equipment.
