HB221, HD1	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.  Provides that certain pregnant women receiving state-funded medical assistance and who receive substance abuse treatment are eligible for substance abuse treatment and related mental health services for an additional ten months following childbirth. (HD1)	HUS/HLT, FIN
HB222, HD1	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Adjusts the method by which the department of human services shall calculate payments to providers of medical care and long-term supports and services. Appropriates funds. (HD1)	HUS, FIN
<u>HB223, HD1</u>	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.  Amends the office of youth services safe spaces for youth pilot program by clarifying access to services, providing a definition of homeless youth, and expanding the age of youth that may be served. Appropriates funds. (HD1)	HUS/HLT, FIN

HB224, HD1 RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. HUS, HSG, FIN

Establishes the Hawaii public housing authority public housing tenant upward mobility pilot program. Permits the Hawaii public housing authority to contract with outside parties to implement the program. Appropriates funds. (HD1)

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. HB225, HD1

HUS, FIN

Amends Act 317, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, to give the department of human services flexibility in developing a comprehensive child welfare information system and extend the

appropriation lapse date. Effective 6/29/23. (HD1)

RELATING TO DISTRICT BOUNDARY AMENDMENTS. HB676

HSG/WAL, JHA

Authorizes the appropriate county land use decision-making authority to determine district boundary amendments involving land areas over fifteen acres if the county has adopted an

ordinance that meets certain requirements.
