H.B. 1109, H.D. 2 RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING

The Department of Transportation (DOT) supports H.B. 1109, H.D. 2, which will meet federal requirements on fraudulent activity relating to Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) and Commercial Driver's License (CDL).
