**Purpose of Bill:** Requires each public employer to pay for the employer's employees' professional license renewal fees. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

#### **Department's Position:**

The Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) provides comments regarding HB 0164 HD1. The Department appreciates efforts to support the recruitment and retention of professional employees statewide by lowering barriers of entry into professions that require a professional license.

If the bill passes, the Department would request that appropriate staffing be included in the bill. The Department does not currently have staff dedicated to track, reimburse, or collect prorated professional licensing fees owed when an employee ceases employment.

As an alternative, the Department recommends all fees be waived or collected at the appropriate licensing agency rather than by the employer.

Additionally, the Department would defer to the Office of Collective Bargaining as to whether this measure would affect the collective bargaining process.
