DEPARTMENT'S POSITION: the Department of Human Services (DHS) supports this

administration measure, provides a comment, and defers to the State Procurement Office and other departments.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this bill abolishes the community council on purchase of

health and human services. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

The HD1 amended the measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to June 30, 3000, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

The bill's justification sheet indicates that the community council no longer serves its intended purpose. DHS agrees that "State agencies and private providers communicating and working together in a dynamic paradigm can refine and update procedures for planning, procuring, and contracting health and human services to meet current needs without the help

of the community council." DHS will work with SPO and the procurement policy board to address any rule changes.

The State Procurement Office (SPO) **strongly supports** this bill, which abolishes the Community Council on Purchase of Health and Human Services by repealing section 103F-202 Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS). The services of the Community Council are no longer required as the administrative rules for Chapter 103F, HRS, have been established. The Procurement Policy Board, established by section 103D-201, HRS, has the authority and responsibility to adopt rules for Chapters 103D and 103F, HRS, pursuant to section 103D-202, HRS.
