Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this bill. The Campaign Spending Commission ("Commission") supports this bill.

This bill establishes an investigator position in the Commission. The Commission has five existing positions. At times, all five positions perform investigative duties. Recently, staff members have been subpoenaed to testify in contested case hearings and in a criminal proceeding regarding their roles in the investigation of those cases. This can be problematic, especially for the general counsel, who is responsible for presenting the case to the Commission where the executive director is the complainant.

The Commission requests that this committee pass this measure.
