Chair Yamashita and Members of the Committee:

The Department of the Attorney General (Department) provides the following comments.

The bill authorizes the School Facilities Authority Board, instead of the Governor, to appoint an Executive Director of the School Facilities Authority, and would amend section 302A-1702, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), to do so. However, it is section 302A-1704, HRS, that establishes the School Facilities Authority Board and sets forth its responsibilities. Because the purpose of this bill is to authorize the School Facilities Authority Board to appoint the Executive Director of the School Facilities Authority, the amendments in this bill would be more properly placed in the statute that describes the responsibilities of the School Facilities Authority Board.

The Department recommends that, instead of amending section 302A-1702(b), HRS, as described in the bill, repeal that subsection and amend section 302A-1704, HRS, to add a new subsection to read as follows:

"The board shall appoint an executive director of the school facilities authority exempt from chapters 76 and 89. The salary of the executive director shall be set by the board and the executive director shall be included in any benefit program generally applicable to the officers and employees of the State."
