FOREWORD

This publication contains important information concerning the bills passed by the Hawaii State Legislature during the Regular Session of 2024, which adjourned *sine die* on May 3, 2024. This publication supplements the publication entitled "Bills Passed by the Hawaii State Legislature, Regular Session of 2024," which was issued by the LRB Systems Office in May 2024 and contains a brief description of each bill passed during the 2024 session.¹

This report consists of the following resources:

- (1) A preliminary index that contains a topical listing of the bills passed during the Regular Session of 2024 under broad and general subject matter categories;
- (2) A table of "Laws Affected by Bills Passed" that shows sections of the Hawaii Revised Statutes; Session Laws of Hawaii; sections of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920; and the proposed constitutional amendments that are affected by bills passed during the Regular Session of 2024. It also includes a listing of new chapters of the Hawaii Revised Statutes. This table reflects information from the final draft of every bill passed by the Legislature during the Regular Session of 2024; and
- (3) A table of "Status of Bills Passed by the Legislature" that provides a listing of bills passed and includes the Act number and approval date, if any, and appropriate committee report numbers.

The foregoing information includes Act numbers and approval dates for bills signed into law or vetoed by the Governor as of June 26, 2024. Information regarding any bills approved by the Governor after June 26, 2024, may be obtained through the Legislature's website at <http://capitol.hawaii.gov/>. The Governor has until July 10, 2024, to consider bills for approval.²
