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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUMMER ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part II, subpart C, to be
3	appropria	tely designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Summer electronic benefits transfer for	
5	children	program. The department shall:
6	(1)	Work with the department of human services to maximize
7		participation in the federal summer electronic
8		benefits transfer for children program established
9		pursuant to the federal Consolidated Appropriations
10		Act, 2023, P.L. 117-328;
11	(2)	Share all data determined by the departments to be
12		necessary to adhere to the requirements of title 42
13		United States Code section 1762 and section 346- ;

15	(3)	Follow the federal guidelines and regulations
16		established pursuant to title IV, division HH, section

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. 1	502 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023, P.L.
2	117-328, to maximize flexibility to distribute summer
3	meals through non-congregate distribution."
4	SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
6	designated and to read as follows:
7	"§346- Summer electronic benefits transfer for children
8	program. (a) Subject to the availability of funds, the
9	department may implement the federal summer electronic benefits
10	transfer for children program. To implement the program, the
11	department shall work with the department of education to
12	maximize participation in the federal summer electronic benefits
13	transfer for children program established pursuant to the
14	federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023, P.L. 117-328.
15	(b) To the extent that appropriations or private funds are
16	made available, the department may contract with one or more
17	providers to administer the summer electronic benefits transfer
18	for children program.
19	(c) The department may accept grants, donations, and
20	contributions from private or public sources for the purposes of

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1 this section, which may be expended consistent with the 2 grantors' or donors' wishes." 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$53,500 or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the 6 summer electronic benefits transfer for children program, 7 including: 8 (1) The establishment of one permanent full-time 9 equivalent (1.0 FTE) program specialist position 10 SR-24; and 11 The hiring of staff, system modifications, and (2) 12 operating expenses. 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 14 education for the purposes of this Act; provided that no funds 15 shall be expended unless matched by federal funds on a 16 dollar-for-dollar basis. 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,050,000 or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the 20 summer electronic benefits transfer for children program,

21 including:

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((1)	The establishment of one permanent full-time
		equivalent (1.0 FTE) program specialist position
		SR-24; and
((2)	The hiring of staff, system modifications, and
		operating expenses.
Г	The s	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
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7 human services for the purposes of this Act; provided that no
8 funds shall be expended unless matched by federal funds on a
9 dollar-for-dollar basis.

SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
provided that sections 3 and 4 shall take effect on July 1,
2024.
