A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that pursuant to section 2 302A-431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the university of Hawaii reported one workers' compensation claim during the fiscal 3 4 biennium of 2014-2016 with a cost impact of \$1,046.36. Since 5 then, no further workers' compensation claims have been made; 6 however, the university is still required by section 302A-431, 7 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to submit a biennium report, whether a 8 claim is made or not.

9 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the university's
10 reporting requirement to identify the cost impacts to the State
11 of providing workers' compensation coverage for university of
12 Hawaii students.

13 SECTION 2. Section 302A-431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended to read as follows:

15 "\$302A-431 Rules[; reporting]. [(a)] The board and the
16 board of regents of the University of Hawaii may adopt necessary
17 rules under chapter 91 to administer and implement sections

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302A-430 and 302A-431, including the adoption of safety 1 2 · guidelines and safety inspection procedures of facilities where students are placed. The department and the University of 3 4 Hawaii shall inspect each facility annually [prior to] before 5 the placement of students with these facilities. 6 [(b) The University of Hawaii shall submit a biennial 7 report to the governor and the legislature prior to the 8 convening of each regular session in the first year of each 9 biennium that identifies the cost impacts to the State of 10 providing workers' compensation coverage for University of 11 Hawaii-students.]" 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
