RELATING TO NOISE POLLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many residents 2 throughout the State, especially those in high density 3 residential areas, have complained about growing noise pollution 4 and disturbances from low restriction mufflers on motor 5 vehicles, predominantly motorcycles. The complainants claim 6 that the noise level adversely affects their sleep, particularly 7 in the early morning hours or late at night. Thus, the noise 8 may have adverse impacts on public health and safety, as well as 9 peaceful enjoyment and quality of life.

10 The legislature further finds that while existing law
11 prohibits vehicle owners from installing mufflers that increase
12 the noise of their vehicle, the penalties are minimal and do
13 little to deter violations. In fact, violators are known to add
14 enhanced noise mufflers after they have passed the county
15 vehicle safety check.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish:

17	violation	and shall be enforceable by law enforcement officers.
18	Any perso	n who violates the provisions of this section may be
19	issued a	summons or citation for the violation. Violation of

15	(b)	[Any] Except as provided in section 291- , any
16	violation	of this section shall constitute a violation and shall
17	be enforc	eable by police officers. [The fine for this violation
18	shall-be	not less than \$25 nor more than \$250 for each separate
19	offense.]	Violation of this section shall subject the violator
20	to the fo	llowing penalties:

12	SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun before its effective date.
15	SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
