RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the coconut 2 rhinoceros beetle can have devastating impacts on palm species 3 that are foundational to the State's agricultural economy, 4 cultural heritage, and ecosystems. The legislature further 5 finds that the use of fine meshed nets can be an effective means of preventing adult coconut rhinoceros beetles from accessing 6 7 vulnerable plants, effectively mitigating their impact on local 8 plants and the environment. Additionally, fine mesh netting, 9 meant for non-aquatic usage, is a regulated device for pest 10 control under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and 11 Rodenticide Act, as amended.

12 The purpose of this Act is to allow for the use of fine 13 meshed nets for the protection of plants against invasive 14 species, under certain conditions.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 17 and to read as follows:

1	" <u>§141-</u> Fine meshed nets; invasive species; permissible;
2	rules. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, fine
3	meshed nets may be used for the protection of plants against
4	invasive species, as determined by the department of
5	agriculture; provided that the fine meshed nets shall be applied
6	in a manner that is unlikely to entangle birds, become dislodged
7	and enter water, or entangle or disturb native and beneficial
8	animals, including but not limited to pollinators, ladybugs or
9	lady beetles, and net-winged insects.
10	(b) The department of agriculture shall adopt rules in
11	accordance with chapter 91 to implement this section, including
12	but not limited to establishing requirements related to filament
13	diameter, color, and the inclusion of visual cues to prevent
14	non-targeted entanglement and prohibiting the use of mist net
15	material that is used for bird work."
16	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
