# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMBLING OFFENSES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECT	ION 1	. Section 712-1220, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by	y ame:	nding the definition of "advance gambling
activity" to read as follows:		
""Advance gambling activity". A person "advances gambling		
activity"	if t	he person:
(1)	Enga	ges in conduct that materially aids any form of

14	provided that on July 1, 2029, this Act shall be repealed and
15	section 712-1220, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in
16	the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective date
