H.B. NO. 1072

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSES TO SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 211, Session
Laws of Hawaii 2021, authorized the issuance of a civil license
to solemnize marriages. Prior to enactment, only individuals
with religious affiliations or judicial appointments could
obtain a license to solemnize marriages.

6 Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, also established fees 7 for a civil license to solemnize marriages, the intent of which 8 was to enhance general revenues from approximately 20,000 9 marriages per year, two-thirds of which are for out-of-state and 10 international couples. However, there are no fees for licenses 11 to solemnize marriages for the religious and judicial marriage 12 solemnizers.

13 The purpose of this Act is to repeal wording related to 14 fees to assure equity among religious, judicial, and civil 15 performers.

16 SECTION 2. Section 572-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended to read as follows:

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1	"§572-11 Marriage ceremony; license to solemnize[+];	
2	<u>fees.</u> (a) It shall not be lawful for any person to perform the	
3	marriage ceremony within the State without first obtaining from	
4	the department of health a license to solemnize marriages. Any	
5	license to solemnize marriages shall be valid for one year from	
6	the date of issuance.	
7	(b) The fee for any license to solemnize marriages shall	
8	be \$100 per year. All fees received for the issuance of	
9	licenses to solemnize marriages shall be remitted to the	
10	director of health. Upon receipt of remittances under this	
11	section, the director shall deposit:	
12	(1) Seventy-five dollars to the vital statistics	
13	improvement special fund established under section	
14	338-14.6; and	
15	(2) Twenty-five dollars to the general fund."	
16	SECTION 3. Section 572-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
17	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
18	"(b) A civil license to solemnize marriages may be issued	
19	to, and the marriage rite may be performed and solemnized by,	
20	any individual at least eighteen years of age, upon presentation	
21	to the individual of a license to marry, as prescribed by this	
22	chapter. An individual with a civil license to solemnize a	

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1 marriage may receive the price stipulated by the parties or any 2 gratuity tendered. [The civil license shall be valid for no 3 less than two years from the date of its issuance; provided that 4 a temporary three-month civil license may be issued upon an 5 individual's request. The fee for a civil license shall be \$100 6 per year the permit is valid; provided that the fee for a 7 temporary three-month license shall be \$25.] An individual who 8 performs a solemnization of a marriage pursuant to a civil 9 license issued under this subsection shall obtain the prior 10 written consent of each person for whom a solemnization is 11 performed and fulfill all provisions of sections 572-13 and 12 572-15 applicable to persons authorized to solemnize marriages." 13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 5. TITLE:	A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LICENSES TO SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES.
PURPOSE :	To establish parity of cost for licenses to solemnize marriages.
MEANS :	Amend sections 572-11 and 572-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
JUSTIFICATION:	Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, established fees for a civil license to solemnize marriages of \$100 for one year and \$25 for three months. However, there is no statutorily established fee for religious or judicial performers to acquire a license; thus, establishing a uniform fee for all types of licenses to solemnize marriages is fair.
	<u>Impact on the public</u> : The bill will establish equitable fees to acquire a license to solemnize marriages.
	Impact on the department and other agencies: This bill will increase deposits to the vital statistics improvement special fund, which will enable the department to make more improvements.
