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JUSTIFICATION SHEET

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EXECUTIVE OFFICE ON AGING ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMING SPECIAL FUND.

PURPOSE: To clarify the allowable revenues to be deposited into the Executive Office on Aging (EOA) Administrative Claiming Special Fund and the purposes for which the fund may be used.

MEANS: Amend section 349-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Programs within EOA are eligible to receive Medicaid administrative claiming moneys. The current wording is overly narrow in scope and unnecessarily restricts the use of funds to provide broader services to more clients.

> <u>Impact on the public:</u> Aging and disability populations may benefit from additional program monies for direct services and supports.

Impact on the department and other agencies: The EOA will be able to use the additional program monies for direct services and supports.
