# H.B. NO. 108

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC NOTICE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that posting notices
electronically is more expedient and cost-effective than
publishing notices on paper, particularly for routine but
time-sensitive situations. Clean water environmental hazard
advisories and urgent conditions like disaster-related response
and recovery activities may be posted more effectively online
than in print.

8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide 9 government agencies the option to publish notices via a posting 10 on the agency's official website, in lieu of or in addition to 11 publishing in a daily or weekly publication such as a printed 12 newspaper.

However, the legislature affirms that under general rules of statutory construction, where two statutes conflict, the more specific statute is followed. As a result, since section 1-28.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is a general statute, this Act is not intended to supersede procedures that, for example,

3	SECTION 2. Section 1-28.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
5	"(a) Notwithstanding any other statute, law, charter
6	provision, ordinance, or rule to the contrary, whenever a
7	government agency is required to give public notice or to
8	publish notice, the notice shall be given only as follows:
9	(1) For statewide publication:
10	(A) In a daily or weekly publication of statewide
11	circulation; or
12	(B) By publication in separate daily or weekly
13	publications whose combined circulation is
14	statewide; [and]
15	(2) For county-wide publication, by publication in a daily
16	or weekly publication in the affected county[-

19	(3) For either statewide or county publication, as
