BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii state legislature finds that paying
2	inheritance and estate taxes is a form of double taxation, as
3	the money was initially taxed in the hands of the recipient. The
4	purpose of this act is to repeal the inheritance and estate tax
5	of the state of Hawaii.
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 236D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	repealed.
8	SECTION 3. Chapter 236E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	repealed.
10	SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
11	taxable years beginning after December 31, 2023.
