## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CARE HOMES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine
4	the rate of payment for domiciliary care, including care
5	provided in licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary
6	homes, community care foster family homes, and certified adult
7	foster homes, to be provided to recipients who are eligible for
8	federal supplementary security income or public assistance, or
9	both. The director shall provide for level of care payment as
10	follows:
11	(1) Beginning on [ <del>July 1, 2008,</del> ] <u>July 1, 2023,</u> for adult
12	residential care homes classified as facility type I,
13	licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary homes
14	as defined under section 321-15.9, community care
15	foster family homes as defined under section 321-481,
16	and certified adult foster homes as defined under

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1	section 321-11.2, the state supplemental payment shall
2	not exceed [ <del>\$651.90</del> ] <u>\$772;</u> and
3	(2) Beginning on July 1, 2008, for adult residential care
4	homes classified as facility type II, the state
5	supplemental payment shall not exceed \$759.90.
6	If the operator does not provide the quality of care
7	consistent with the needs of the individual to the satisfaction
8	of the department, the department may remove the recipient to
9	another facility.
10	The department shall handle abusive practices under this
11	section in accordance with chapter 91.
12	Nothing in this subsection shall allow the director to
13	remove a recipient from an adult residential care home or other
14	similar institution if the recipient does not desire to be
15	removed and the operator is agreeable to the recipient
16	remaining, except where the recipient requires a higher level of
17	care than provided or where the recipient no longer requires any
18	domiciliary care."
19	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
21	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and

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1	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2	year 2024-2025 to provide state supplemental payments in the
3	amount of \$772 to licensed care home providers for each client
4	eligible for federal supplemental security income or public
5	assistance, or both, under the care of providers authorized
6	under section 346-53(c)(1), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
7	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8	of human services for the purposes of this Act.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
