
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to
4 establish ten full-time equivalent (10.0 FTE) permanent
5 positions within the employee staffing division of the
6 department of human resources development for the recruitment
7 and retention of state employees.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 human resources development for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
11 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
13 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
14 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
15 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
16 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
17 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further


1 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
2 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
3 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
4 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
5 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
6 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

- 7 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
8 serve the public interest; and
9 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
10 addressed by this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
